



TOBACCO, DRUG AND ALCOHOL-FREE ENVIRONMENT

Tobacco, drugs and alcohol have the potential to put children and educator’s wellbeing at risk. These substances can compromise effective supervision of children. It is important for educators to role model safe behaviours with regards to these substances.

Procedure:

- All children will be cared for in an environment free from the use of tobacco, illicit drugs and alcohol.
- Educators, Volunteers, work experience students and visitors must not be affected by alcohol when on the premises and the service is operating.
- Educators, Volunteers, work experience students and visitors must not be affected by drugs which adversely affect the person’s ability to educate and care for children when on the premises when the service is operating.
- All DfE sites are tobacco free.
